If your quilt meets that criteria, please include a backing at least 4" larger in all dimensions than your quilt top and enough binding to complete the quilt. The board will make the final decision on which quilts will be quilted at the club's expense. If you are unable to quilt your smaller quilt, someone in the club might complete it for you or you can pay Terri or another professional to quilt it for you.
